Alexandra Baig is the Executive Director of P.A.C.E. (Path to Academics, Community and Employment), a post-secondary program for young adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities at National Louis University in Chicago. She also helps people with disabilities to access all the public benefits for which they are eligible. Alexandra's first career was an equity analyst in Hong Kong and Shanghai. A search for a more meaningful life's work took her to L'Arche, an international, interfaith network of communities where people with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities share life. Her work at L'Arche introduced Alexandra to the financial planning challenges of people with physical, intellectual, developmental and behavioral disabilities and their families. In her consulting role, Alexandra educates clients as necessary on how they can make the best use of Social Security, Medicaid, Medicare and their own resources to support a financially secure life for everyone in the family, particularly the member with disabilities. Her goal is to help people with disabilities find the resources to live up to their full potentials.
